

# Getting started with the Libby app for eBooks and eAudiobooks

The free Libby app is the easiest way to get started with digital books and audiobooks from the Kitimat Public Library. Libby is available for Android, iOS, Windows 10, some Chromebooks, and in your browser at [libbyapp.com](http://libbyapp.com).

## STEP 1

Install the Libby app from your device's app store.

- Apple App Store
- Google Play
- Windows Store

Or, visit [libbyapp.com](http://libbyapp.com) in your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge browser.

## STEP 2

In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.

## STEP 3

Browse your library's collection by tapping on “**Library**” at the bottom of the screen, then either scroll down or refine your search by tapping on the search box at the top of the screen.

## STEP 4

Once you find a book, tap on the book's image and tap on either borrow or reserve.

## STEP 5

Borrowed titles appear under **Shelf** --> **Loans (located at the bottom of the screen)**. Titles will download automatically when you're connected to Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

From your **Loans**, you can:

- Tap **Open Audiobook** or **Open Book** to start reading or listening to the title.
- Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew Loan** and **Return/Return Early**.
