Library Youth Intern – Temporary Contract Position (minimum 21 hours per week)

Under the supervision of the Library Director, the Library Youth Intern will coordinate and perform a variety of technical services duties, with a focus on E-resources training and website enhancement. The Library Youth Intern will be provided with necessary training. This is a union position.

Duties:

The Library Youth Intern will be responsible for the following duties:

- to perform data entry for the Library's new website
- to provide training to the public on electronic apps
- to train the public on internet searching, browsing, on-line safety and security
- to prepare advertising using multiple methods
- to publish and/or distribute advertising
- other tasks as assigned

Qualifications:

- has strong social skills and enjoys working with the public
- has strong communication skills, both written and oral
- possesses a sound knowledge of electronic devices' usage
- has strong typing abilities

- is a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or has refugee status in Canada
