December was our construction month as the new wall was installed. There are small finishes to happen, but otherwise it was a great success. We also had a visit from Science World, arranged by our Northwest Library Federation. We held 2 events for Science World and it was packed at both events. We also offered 5 children's events over the Christmas holidays. These were well-attended and got everyone into the mood for Christmas!

We were closed for the week of December 11-15, 2023 for the wall installation and everything went very smoothly. We were able to allow patrons in for picking up their holds or if they had questions but remained closed to the public for computer use. Our Wi-Fi was available within a certain range of our building for patrons at anytime of the day.

Shawn has been working very hard in December to finish off all the tech stuff to make sure that the new Zoom phones are working. We now have everything installed and are excited that the new phones have voicemail and caller ID.

Our website had an overhaul during November and it now meets the accessibility standards as outlined in the Accessibility Act. There are still some pages that need more fine tuning, but the home page is completely done.

The next NWLF conference is scheduled for September and will be held at the Kitimat Library. The dates are still to be determined.

We were able to partner with Shames Mountain to offer free ski passes to our library patrons again this year. This was made possible because of LNG Canada. There are 4 passes available during the mountains opening days from December 16th til March 31st, 2024.
