Director's Report May - June 2024

Quite a few of our projects seem to be on hold while we wait for the District workers to complete other jobs before coming over to the library. I hope that we can get our jobs finished up before the annual swimming pool maintenance. The current projects are, the mural on the moveable wall, the hanging tracks and some minor repairs around the library.

We have completed all the government reporting for the year and are just waiting on the approval and funds to be distributed.

We have been cleaning up our storage upstairs with great success. We have got rid of many old items that were either expired or broken. We are still scanning the older minutes and paperwork from upstairs in hopes of preserving this history. The last step is to go through the archives and see what books we have floating around and if they are still in good condition. We may work with the Museum to give them some of these older items.
